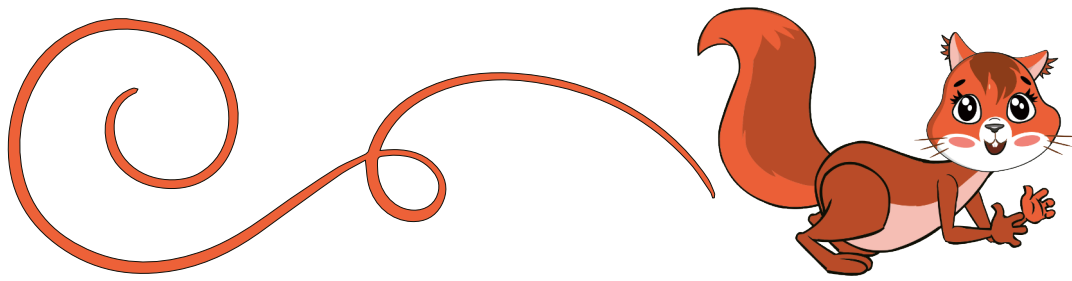

It's a beautiful day.

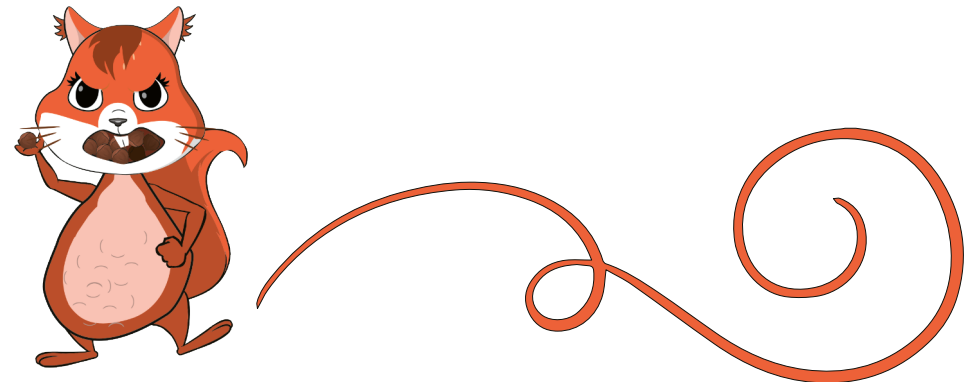
Feodora and Gino are going into the forest.

There are many lovely flowers, fresh berries, and little crawlers.

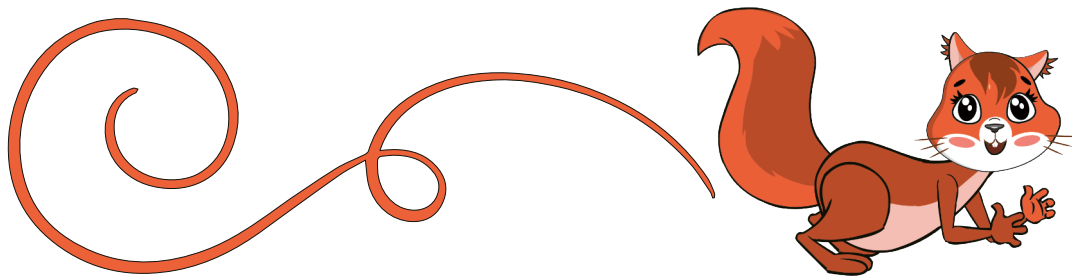
Feodora loves little animals.

After a few steps, they meet their teacher, Mr. Weichwickler.

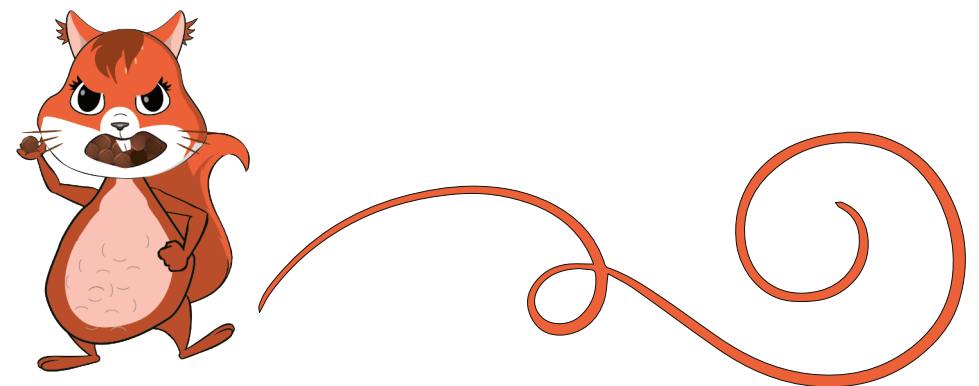
He's kind and always speaks in rhymes.

Mr. Weichwickler says, "Hello, children, it's great to see,

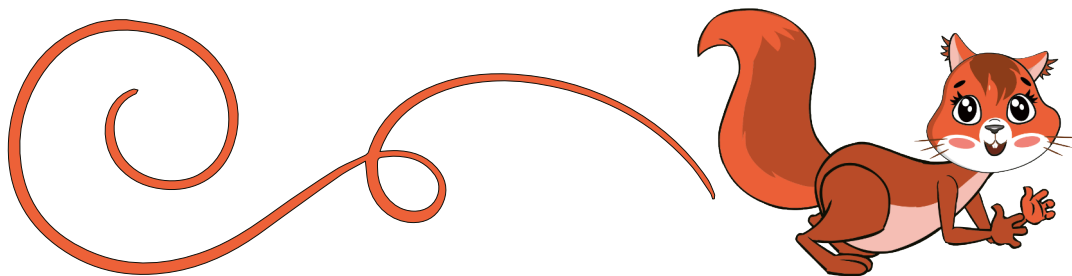
I'd love to walk, but my basket's heavy for me.

Feodora and Gino grin.

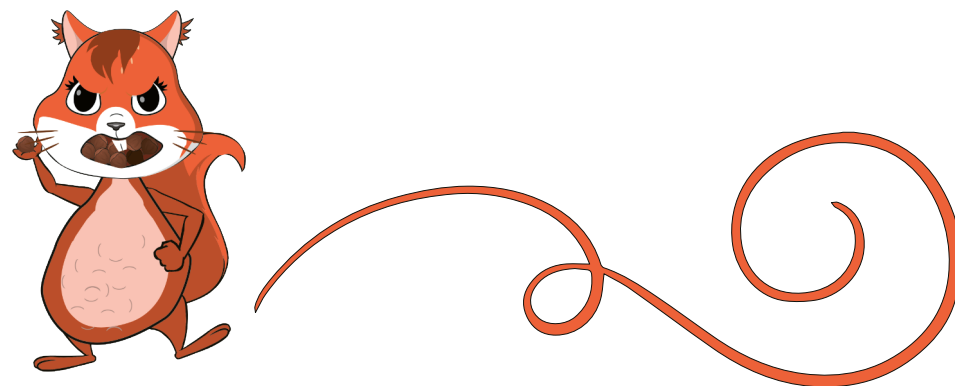
Mr. Weichwickler's basket is full of nuts and mushrooms.

The children nod.

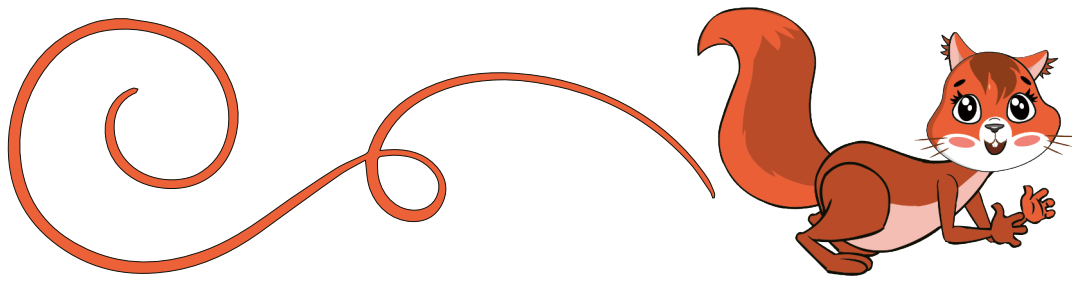
Gino says, "Of course! A pirate's honor word!"

so keep them safe, that's the cure!"

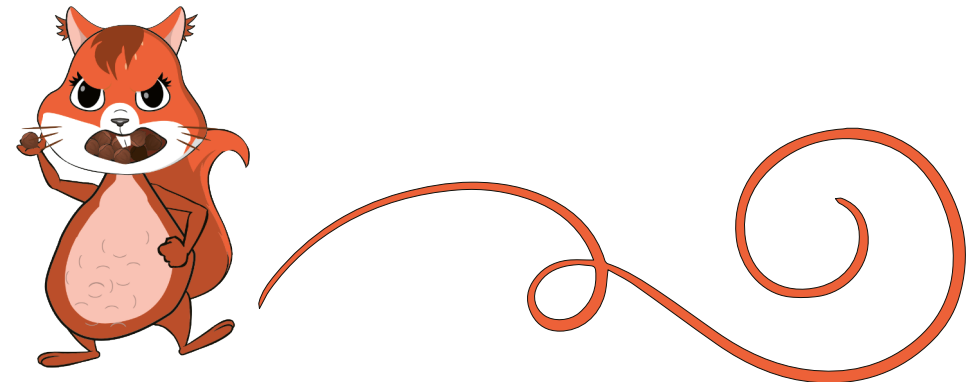
Then he says goodbye.



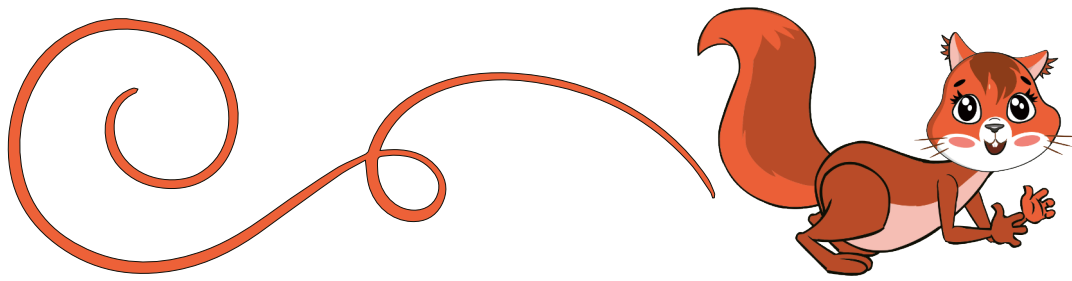




The children sit down under a tree.

It's crawling up the tree.







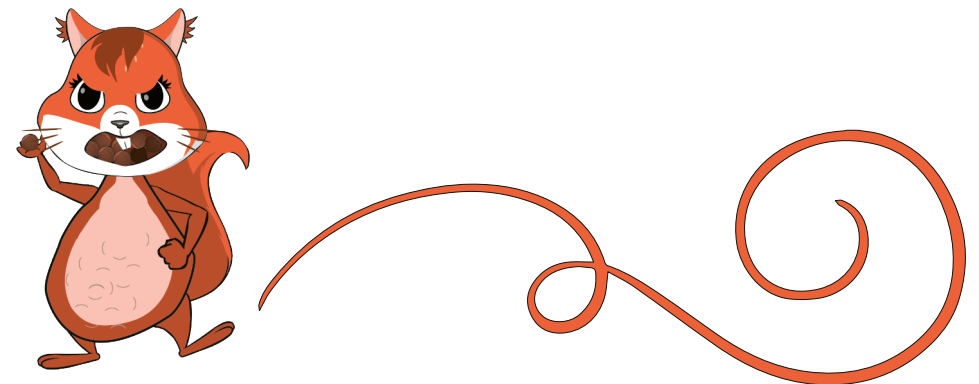
Then Feodora sees a hole in the tree.

She says, "Gino, look! I wonder who lives there?"

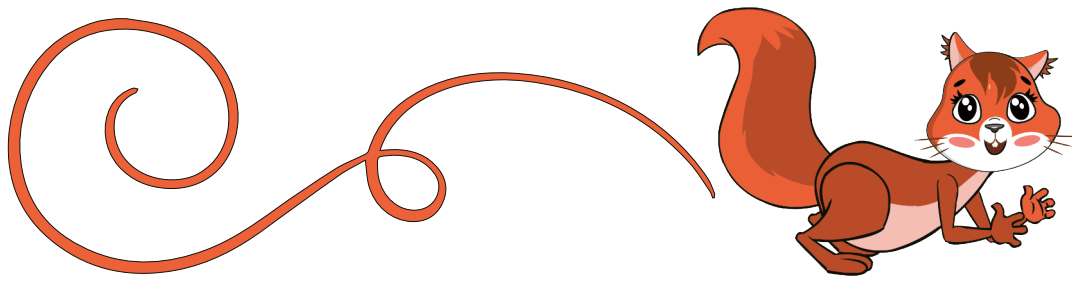
Gino says, "I'll climb up and have a look!"

Feodora nods.

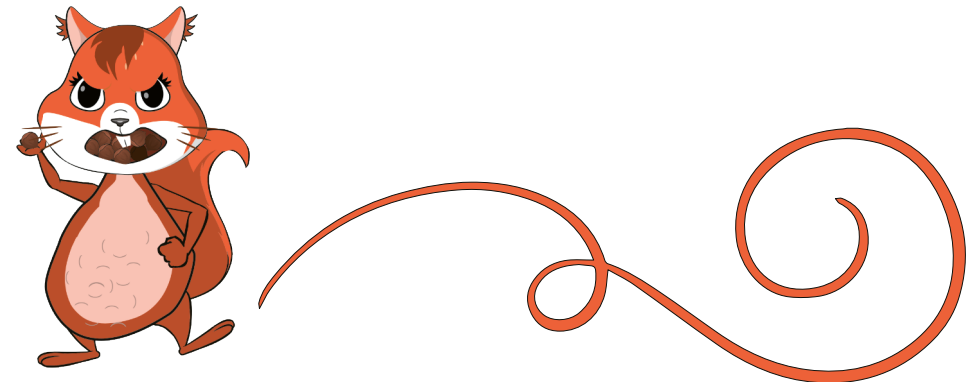
Gino is a great climber.





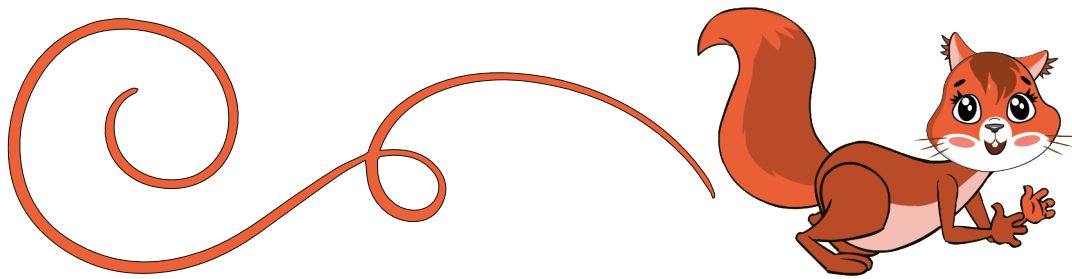


When Gino reaches the top, he looks into the hole.
